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GEMS code of Conduct

Each GEM is expected to:

- Respect their counselors and fellow GEMS.
- Come to all regular nights and special events prepared and on time.
- Notify her counselor or head counselor ahead of time if she is unable to make a night or event.
- Come to all nights in their GEMS uniform unless otherwise specified by your GEMS counselor.
- Refrain from bringing any electronic devices to GEMS nights and outings. Such devices with be confiscated for the duration of the night or outing.
- 6. Respect the facilities of Providence CRC.

Parents:

- 1. Be available during each GEMS night/event should a need arise.
- You must sign your GEM IN and OUT each night. NO GEM will leave the building until they are properly signed out.
- 3. Be aware that if your daughter breaks the rules or misbehaves beyond reasonable limits, she may be sent home and we will call you to pick her up.
- 4. Bring any concerns about the GEMS programs or its counselors to the head counselor's (Sharise or Jenn)
- 5. Be aware the GEMS counselors are volunteers who give freely of their time and are not necessarily trained as educators or youth workers but are here because they feel God calling them to minister to your daughter.

- 6. In the event of an emergency counselors may need to seek professional help before they are able to notify parents/guardians.
- 7. Must provide necessary medical and contact information at the beginning of each GEMS season.

** Please DO not send your daughter if she is sick. We will call parents to pick up their girls if they show any symptom(s) of illness.**
